Why Alliance Reliability Matters

Trash day. If you want to get a sense for the level of throwaway society we have become, that day of the week will give you a full view. Appliances, furniture, and everything in between – "they just don't make things like they used to" is the cry of every consumer dragging these items, many only a couple years old, to the curb. Most of which will end up in the landfill.

At Alliance Laundry Systems, we refuse to let our retail products be part of the landfill problem. We could build cheaper machines, engineer for shorter life spans, use more inexpensive, lesser quality raw materials...we could do that, but we won't. We won't apologize for our commercial quality, heavy-duty components, or extensive life cycle testing. We are unwavering in our commitment to deliver ultimate reliability to consumers – they deserve the best and our planet needs it now more than ever.

By the numbers, Alliance Laundry Systems makes a difference every day producing machines designed for more than 25 years of life in the average home, where the industry average is roughly seven to 10 years.

Based on just **2020 retail sales alone**, we'll keep between **796,000 and 1.2 million machines** out of the landfill.

That's enough washers and dryers to fill between 6,300 and 9,500 semi-trailers.

For scale, that's roughly a traffic jam of **60 to 94 miles of trailers put end to end** ... and that's the benefit of just one year of our retail sales. Alliance Laundry Systems durability makes a difference every day. That's our steadfast commitment.



A Multi-Housing Leader

In the multi-housing market, Alliance equipment is the choice of property managers focused on maximum reliability and efficiency in their community laundry rooms. Additionally, with an install base of more than two million machines, our positive impact on the environment and conservation of resources versus in-unit installations is dramatic.

Selecting in-unit laundry equipment comes at a cost to the environment. Properties send more

washers and dryers to landfills, due to the shorter life spans of cheaper residential units.

Renters also do more loads, most of which are partial loads, and that leads to greater use of water – exacerbated by the washers' inefficiency.

The Ultra-high Extraction Speeds

on our washer-extractors deliver further savings on the drying side – reducing dry times versus low-speed models. The result is on-premises laundries can see gas and electric savings of up to 237 million kWh annually, equivalent to more than 22,000 households' yearly consumption.

Our Industry-exclusive OPTispray™ feature helps on-premises laundries reduce water consumption in rinse cycles by 39% versus conventional bath-style rinses. Saving 125 million gallons of water annually equates to 30,000 tankers.





OPTidry™ Over-dry Protection Technology

helps reduce gas and electric consumption through highly accurate moisture sensing, which results in less drying and greater labor savings. Cutting just **6 minutes** of over-drying can save **298 million kWh** annually, equivalent to more than 27,000 households' yearly consumption.




Building Community Through Respect and Support of Human Dignity

In the areas served by our equipment, laundromats can be safe areas, spaces that foster a sense of community—places where kids can play while parents perform an essential chore.


With clean clothes, people stand a bit taller and feel better about themselves. Hygiene directly contributes to human dignity.

Going Beyond Products and Pursuing Solutions that Keep our Planet and People Safe



While we are excited that our process is effective on most "dry clean-only" items, we are proud that it is safer for staff and better for our environment.

A Strong Safety Culture and a Healthy Work Environment

At our locations around the world, we rigorously review our safety practices in a continuous quest for zero harm. For all team members, safety and an improved work environment are an ongoing focus. Our data shows exceptional progress in reducing incidents.

Starting in 2022, we will implement an internal Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) management system that follows ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 45001



All Alliance facilities are designated smoke-free workplaces and we offer annual company-wide on-site medical screening to encourage team members to take an active role in their wellness.

Our Manufacturing Commitment to the Environment

Our commitment to making the world a cleaner place extends into business operations. We consistently look for ways to reduce our consumption of natural resources at our manufacturing locations around the world. Our results include:

Team members and visitors at our Thailand plant can observe in real time how solar panels contribute to our overall electric consumption. There's a monitor in our lobby that tracks the amount of energy the panels generate and translates it into savings on our electric bill. The panels generate an estimated THB70,000 in electric savings each month which is 6.5% of our total electric cost. There are 2,498 panels covering 4,996 square meters. The panels were installed in partnership with WHA, the owner of the industrial land where our plant is located.



Rising to the Challenge of COVID-19

With our equipment on the front lines in the battle against COVID-19, Alliance Laundry Systems facilities around the globe shined – balancing continuity of service with an even higher degree of safety through teamwork and regular, transparent communication with our employees.

When team members at our Guangzhou, China facility were battling PPE shortages in the early days of the pandemic, U.S. employees answered the call and sent 2,000 masks to assist. Months later, as our U.S. plants were in the throes of the same challenge, Chinese teammates returned the favor, with a shipment of masks for Ripon, Wis. staff as well teammates in Czech Republic and Thailand.



Quick action by global staff in deploying new COVID-19 protocols:

- Deep cleaning our facilities, including manufacturing
- Implementing a no-visitors policy at all offices/facilities
- Implementing a company-wide work-from-home policy, unless it is critical to be in the office



Alliance Laundry Systems also took the lead in trying to address the shortage of crucial N95 masks by working collaboratively with university researchers to develop a method for disinfecting the PPE. Donating hundreds of hours, Alliance engineers and lab personnel crafted a process that utilizes a specific Alliance-built tumble dryer model to triple the life of N95 masks.

Anti-Harassment and Discrimination

Every newly hired U.S. team member completes Anti-Harassment and Discrimination training within their first two months of joining the company. We are expanding this requirement to all global team members in 2022.

Code of Conduct

Newly hired salaried team members are required to complete the Alliance Laundry Systems Code of Conduct training within 30 days of starting with the company. Team members complete refresher training every two years.

New Team Member Onboarding

Our global production team members receive a blend of classroom, hands-on learning and mentoring to ensure they have the knowledge and skills needed to work safely and maintain high quality standards. Office-based positions receive on-the-job orientation and training based on the needs of the position.

Ergonomic Initiative - Protecting our Laundry MVPs

Our manufacturing team truly is made up of laundry's most valuable players (MVPs). We are resolute in our commitment to keep them safe and injury-free. Recently, we turned to technology to not just reduce injury risk but adapt workstations to eliminate strain and produce greater comfort. In just one year of tapping the Velocity EHS motion capture system, we performed **28 quantitative assessments**, and **reduced injury risk by 34 percent** in those areas.

We will continue to leverage the technology to mitigate risks and give our manufacturing team all the tools for peak MVP performance.
